An example label is printed below showing the required information. Please feel free to make your own label. (Hand written is fine)

Paintings should be dropped off on the day by 9am and (picked up at 4pm) in the Fernside hall. If you cannot manage to be there at these times please arrange pick up and drop off with another member.

*As there will be no EFT-POS facility available we will act as a liaison point and provide contact details so sellers and purchasers can conclude sales.*
